Notification

The 30th January, 2020

No. ED/2020/2818.—Whereas the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh, in exercise of the powers conferred on him under Section 5 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986) read with Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Notification No. S.O. 667 (E), dated the 10th September, 1992, had issued a Notification No. ED/2019/1648 dated 27.09.2019 with directions that no person including a shopkeeper, vendor, whole seller or retailer, trader, hawker or rehriwala etc. shall manufacture, store, import, sell, transport, supply or use plastic, thermocol, Styrofoam items mentioned in the said Notification, from the date of its issuance except the items mentioned at Sr. Nos. 12 to 18 which were directed to be banned after 3 months from the date of issuance of the Notification dated 27.09.2019.

Now, in partial modification of the Notification No. ED/2019/1648 dated 27.09.2019, the Administrator, Union Territory, Chandigarh, hereby directs that for the items mentioned at Serial Nos.12, 13, 14 & 15, the complete ban has become effective from 28.12.2019, however, the items mentioned at Serial No.16, 17 and 18 shall be banned with effect from 28.03.2020. At Serial No.14, plastic sachets with packaging capacity of "50 ml/gm. or less" shall be read as "30ml or less" with effect from 28.12.2019.
