

MONTHLY REPORT FOR THE MONTH OF AUGUST 2019

SUBMITTED BY DISTRICT LEVEL SPECIAL TASK FORCE

The 13th Meeting of District Level Special Task Force was held on 30.8.2019 under the Chairmanship of Deputy Commissioner in D.C. Office, Chandigarh to discuss the action taken to control the pollution in river Ghaggar. Thereafter, the status of all the discharge points of Sukhna Choe and N-Choe were discussed.

1) Status of tenders w.r.t. upgradation of STPs and construction of new STPs.

Sh. Gagandeep Singh, Manager, Chandigarh Smart City Limited, informed that the tender for up gradation of existing STPs and Construction of 1 new STP has been floated after modifications w.r.t. revised effluent parameters as per the order of NGT. The last date of submission and opening of technical bids is 12.09.2019.

2) Status of action taken by M.C., Chandigarh regarding non-compliance of existing STPs

Sh. I.D. Sharma, S.D.E., P.H., Municipal Corporation, Chandigarh informed that existing/old STPs are not meeting with the norms and intimated that all the STPs will comply with the norms, only after their upgradation.

Further Sh. Vivek Pandey, Scientist 'B', Chandigarh Pollution Control Committee, informed that Maloya STP has started.

3) Status of action taken by M.C., Chandigarh and Engineering Department regarding stoppage of untreated discharge of wastewater into Choes along with clear timelines and date of completion of work.

Status of all the discharge points of Sukhna Choe, N-Choe & Faida Choe were discussed.

So, in the meeting of Executive Committee, Chief Inspector of Factories was directed to inspect the industries w.r.t proper working conditions of labours and to provide the report.
